#### Two Arizona Restaurants Receive Coveted DiRoNA Award

Tonto Bar & Grill, and Cartwright's Sonoran Ranch House are two Arizona restaurants that have received the coveted Distinguished Restaurants of North America (DiRoNA) award. This distinction belongs to only 800 restaurants throughout the U.S. Canada and Mexico. There are now three restaurants in the state of Arizona to hold this honor.

DiRoNA, a non-profit organization, serves as an independent authority for recognizing and promoting excellence in dining. DiRoNA's independent inspectors explore nominated restaurants across the United States, Canada, and Mexico to find those worthy of the DiRoNA distinction.

DiRoNA was established in 1990 to promote the distinguished dining industry. To be eligible, restaurants must be in operation, under the same ownership and theme, for a minimum of two years. A rigorous, anonymous inspection process scrutinizes every aspect of the dining experience - food, wine, service, physical property and décor.

The DiRoNA distinction is bestowed upon establishments that represent top quality in distinguished dining. To date, fewer than 800 restaurants have earned the DiRoNA distinction. For more information go to <http://www.dirona.com>
